New Developments in the Bobby Hutton Case

New information has come to light regarding the murder of former Black Panther, Lil Bobby Hutton, in Oakland CA, April 6th 1968.

A former Black Oakland police officer who was at the scene has released a copy of his deposition taken on April 10th, 1968.

His statement was suppressed by the Oakland Police Department and not released to the Grand Jury at the time because it contradicted the Police Department official story.

In his statement, he says that after Eldridge and Bobby surrendered, coming out with their hands up, they were being beaten and pushed along with gun butts.

When Lil Bobby stumbled, a white Emeryville motorcycle officer came up and point blank, shot him in the head.

Other officers then began to fire at him also. This was clearly an assassination which was covered up by the Oakland Police Department.

The It's About Time Committee has contacted the Hutton family and they are calling for a full investigation into these allegations and the violation of Bobby Hutton's civil rights.
