# **INTERNATIONAL SOLIDARITY SUMMIT – UAACC TANZANIA, EAST AFRICA**

**We are planning this historic journey for December 18-20th, 2009.**

**The main focus will be on International Solidarity and to offer support to UAACC and their many community based programs. For those who want to be home for the holidays, we recommend extending your trip on the front end before the conference and give yourself at least 2 weeks if possible.**

**In addition to the conference, there will be the opportunity to take several side trips, including a safari to Ngorongoro Crater, a visit to Zanzibar, overnight at traditional Maasai village, day hike on Mt. Kilimanjaro and visits to Arusha and other parks and villages.**

**We suggest that people pick up a Kiswahili book and learn some basic phrases. Get your passports soon as that can take several weeks.**

**Visit the CDC (Centers for Disease Control) website for suggested vaccinations although most are not mandatory. You will need malaria prophylaxis medication.**

**Book air travel as soon as possible. The nearest airport is Kilimanjaro (JRO). The only international flights from the US to JRO are on KLM and Ethiopian Airlines which flies out of Washington DC and has the best fares. Other airlines fly to Nairobi, Kenya which is a 4 hour bus ride or short commuter flight to Kilimanjaro for those who want to spend time in Nairobi and include Virgin Atlantic and British Air. You can also fly into Dar es Salaam on the coast and visit Zanzibar first and then fly to Kilimanjaro. Groups of 10 or more can get a break on fares, so you may want to try to coordinate from regions.**
