Between 7:30 A.M. and 8:00 A.M., a representative of the loter-nal flewence Services Alcohol and Tshacco Tax Divisionaccompanied by numbers of the indianapolis Pig Department appeared at Pumber Hes-Spatters with a warrest to search for unregistered automatic wearons.

Before the raid Harris had two dreamod-up incidents to his credit.
