It's About Time is offering Photo exhibits and displays of original Black Panther Party (BPP) memorabilia. The exhibits were put together by Billy X Jennings, BPP Historian, from the archives of It's About Time. We are offering four different exhibits.

Exhibit#1 - The Early years: 1966-1969

This exhibit focuses on the beginning of the BPP. Photos include Panthers at the Capital in Sacramento, Free Huey rallies, rallies at Bobby Hutton Park, and photos of the Panthers' Free Breakfast Program. Also included in the exhibit are Panther buttons from that period, posters, and other material produced by the BPP. 35+ photos

Exhibit#2 - Serving the People: Social Programs of the BPP

The BPP started and sponsored many programs to serve the community. This exhibit highlights the work done in the community. Photos will show the Free Breakfast Programs, the Bussing to Prison Program, the Free Pest Control Program, the Free Medical Clinics, Voter Registerion, Free Food Giveaways and more. 35 photos

Exhibit#3 - The Black Panther Party Newspaper Exhibit

The BPP newspaper was the voice of the Party. The paper was started in 1967, and continued until 1980 with over 600 issues printed over that time. We have over 500 issues of the BPP newspaper and we have selected 50 issues for this exhibit. The exhibit will also have 20 photos showing Panthers working on the newspapers in varies stages of production. Many of the newspapers have the art of Emory Douglas on the back cover.

Exhibit#4 - Underground Newspapers of the 60's and 70's exhibit.

Our archives also include rare and hard to find Underground newspapers. The exhibit will include Berkeley Barbs, Berkeley Tribes, the Chicago Seed, the Other from New York, the BPP newspaper, the Militant, Good Times, Hard Times, and the Rat, also out of New York. The exhibit includes 40-50 newspapers and buttons.
