We talked about other political prisoner's cases. They wanted to know about the It's About Time Website and what is happening with comrades outside. We covered many subjects, plus our recent visit to Tanzania in December.

Brother Parnell Herbert arrived and it was good to see him. I didn't know Parnell knew Albert growing up and went to school with him. Brother Parnell is a playwright and his current production is the Angola 3 play which Gail and I had a chance see last year. It's very powerful and educational, about life in Angola prison and the Angola 3 brothers (The play Angola 3 will be performed July 23rd at TSU college in Houston. It will be part of the Carl Hampton celebration weekend).

Time flew by so fast, but Zulu and I had a good talk about launching his support group. I told him I would take the led and help form it and put out information about him. Brother Zulu was a part of the Angola Prison chapter of the BPP back when it was formed in the 1970's and has stayed true to the cause since that time. We must help this brother get a lawyer.
